



FALL SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION OPENS FOR STUDENTS PURSUING MANUFACTURING CAREERS

ELGIN, Ill., Jan. 2, 2019 – Nuts, Bolts & Thingamajigs® (NBT), the Foundation of the Fabricators & Manufacturers Association, Int'l.® (FMA), is accepting scholarship applications for the fall 2019 semester now through March 31. NBT awards scholarships valued at up to \$2,500 to deserving students pursuing a degree which leads to a manufacturing career. Approximately 25 scholarships will be awarded this season.

Eligible applicants are full-time students enrolled in a manufacturing-related course of study or a skilled trade program leading to a career in manufacturing.

Students must hold a minimum GPA and are responsible for submitting academic

records and a manufacturing-related program description with each application.

Students pursuing degrees in the [recommended fields of study](#) are encouraged to apply.
